After reviewing our self-study and site visit report, the Council on Education for Public Health fully accredited our B.A. Public Health Policy and B.S. Public Health Sciences (2012–2017). However, the Association of Schools and Programs in Public Health (ASPPH) recently issued the *Undergraduate Baccalaureate Critical Component Elements*. We propose two specific objectives: (1) Survey Majors (N = 1,400) and assess competence regarding articulated learning objectives before and after required lower-division (PH-1 and PH-2) and upper-division (PH-101 and PH-195W) courses, and (2) Assess student competence and curriculum alignment with ASPPH criteria and the National Board of Public Health Examiners Certification.
